The **Al Maha Desert Conservation Reserve** in Dubai is a great example of an Eco Tourism destination.



Led by local guides, visitors can tour the desert reserve and learn about its wildlife. For example, until recently there were only 500 Arabian Oryx left in the wild. They have now been reintroduced and bred within the desert reserve to preserve the species.




At the Al Maha, visitors learn about the culture and heritage of local desert tribes in the evenings. The hotel also uses solar energy as its power source and recycles and purifies water.
